BRIEF ITINERARY

Day 1:

0830: Depart Stratford-Upon-Avon for Blackwell House
Introduction to Blackwell and then tour the house independently. Lunch
(included) before departing for Glasgow where we check in to our hotel and meet our Scottish Tour Leader

Day 2:

The morning starts with full Scottish breakfast before we transfer by coach to the Hunterian Art Gallery and Mackintosh House. We learn more about Charles Rennie Mackintosh at the Glasgow School of Art before a pre-booked two course lunch is served at the celebrated Willow Tearooms. We spend the afternoon at Kelvingrove where some of the finest collections in Europe are housed. The evening is free for independent dining and pursuits

Day 3:

After breakfast we depart for Scotland's capital, Edinburgh where we'll be given a short tour of the city before a guided tour of the highlights of the National Gallery of Scotland. The gallery is within walking distance of Princes Street or The Royal Mile and there will be free time for lunch and individual sightseeing after the visit. Before leaving Edinburgh we will see The Scottish Parliament at Holyrood before returning to Glasgow. Free evening for independent dining and pursuits

Day 4:

We travel out of the city after breakfast and visit Hill House at Helensburgh with a glimpse of Loch Lomond en route. On our return we visit Bellahouston Park and House for an Art Lover. We end the day with a final dinner at The Glasgow Art Club where we dine in the Gallery

We spend the morning touring The Burrell Collection before departing for Stratford with comfort stops en route
